"If in doubt, don't"warm weather has arrived and we'd like to share some ongoing concerns about the dress code asking for parental support. In order to provide a safe, positive and effective learning environment for our students, the Mace's Lane dress code must remain consistent, i.e.,

- All students should have their pants pulled up and secured; undergarments are not to be visible.
- Shoes will be properly laced or fastened on students' feet. Slippers of any kind (Chinese or similar types) will not be allowed.
- Shorts and skirts will extend beyond the fingertips when standing upright.
- All tops, blouses, or shirts will cover the upper body, as well as the lower torso area while standing upright as well as while seated. Tank tops, or shirts with "spaghetti straps" or "tube tops" are not allowed. Blouses must completely cover front and back. No mesh materials are allowed.
- Any clothing that depicts profanity, obscenity and violence or that promotes use of tobacco, drugs or alcohol is prohibited.

The school principal has the responsibility of making the final decision regarding the appropriateness of attire. Failure to comply will result in a call to parents/guardians to provide appropriate clothing/shoes to amend the infraction. We need our parents to support us in this endeavor!
